REGISTRATION, INSPECTION & APPROVAL

• WHEN: Registration begins at 12:00 pm and closes at 1:30 pm. Pre-registration is optional, but it will help us if you will complete the attached Parade Entry Form and return it my mail no later than November 22, 2024.

Approval and inspection of parade participants and payment is made at check-in, the day of the event, at the beginning of the parade line-up.

• WHERE: Line-up begins at the intersection of 12th Street and West G Street. Once you have checked in, passed a safety inspection, and been approved, you will be directed to your place in the parade line-up, along both sides of West "G" Street. One representative from each group must sign in and provide the required information to the BCA representative.

LINE-UP

- WHEN: The parade begins at 2:00 pm and all parade participants should be in place, ready to move, no later than 1:30 pm.
- High School bands, drill teams and ROTC members should unload on West F street, near Central Avenue, between the Butner Public Safety building and old fire station, and walk to the vacant field located behind the old fire station now called the "Butner Public Safety Training Facility". DO NOT UNLOAD on Central Avenue or try to pull into the vacant field for drop-off. Once students are dropped off, all band and ROTC transport vehicles should be relocated and parked along "A" Street, at the end of the parade, for pick-up after the parade has completed.

PARADE ROUTE

• The parade will begin at the intersection of West "G" Street and Central Avenue, and travel east on Central Avenue, ending at "A" Street. Parade participants can only exit the parade on "A" street, either towards the National Guard Armory or towards Newton Instruments, unless instructed by Butner Public Safety to exit the parade. All vehicles should come to a complete stop before participants disembark. Please keep a safe distance behind the parade entry in front of you.

PARADE RULES

- Parade rules are established to ensure that everyone attending or participating in the parade has a festive and safe environment.
- Parade themes: All parade entries **must have a Christmas theme** and be appropriately decorated. If your parade entry is not Christmas-oriented, you will not be allowed in the parade. The Butner Community Association has the final determination of what is appropriate.
- Parade entry fees are as follows:
 - Free Non-profit, Civic & Government organizations, High School Marching Bands, Drill Teams, ROTC, Firetrucks and Emergency Vehicles

- \$10 per truck/float/trailer combination for businesses
- \$10 Walking Groups (dance, sports, martial arts, horses), fee is per group
- \$10 Motorized Vehicles (car, truck, motorcycle, or golf cart), fee is per vehicle
- Music Christmas music is the **only music allowed** in the parade and **"explicit lyrics" are prohibited.** Violators will be instructed by Butner Public Safety to exit the parade.
- Candy the distribution of candy is allowed, but it is not required. We urge you to limit how much is
 distributed and be careful when tossing the candy so not to injure anyone. Please keep in mind that other
 parade participants are also distributing candy.
- One Santa Rule The BCA provides a float at the end of the parade for Santa. No other Santas are allowed in the parade.
- Noise loud noises from cars and motorcycles revving their engines are not allowed and violators may be instructed by Butner Public Safety to exit the parade.
- All parade vehicles are prohibited from performing burnouts, wheelies or participating in any other reckless or negligent actions. All wheels must remain on the road at all times.
- All NC traffic laws are applicable during the parade. Any violators may be asked to exit the parade route.
- Responsibility For all parade participants, the leader of that group accepts responsibility for the communication of all parade rules to all participants in his/her group and to abide by all the rules of the parade. By participating in the parade, the leader, and all participants, agree to waive and hold harmless the members of the Butner Community Association and the Town of Butner, of all liabilities and responsibility for any injury, damage or loss sustained by participants, guests, or vehicles before, during and after the parade.
- Adult supervision is required for all children under the age of 14.
- All body parts must be kept inside the vehicle, floats, and trailers. Vehicles must come to a complete stop before participants disembark.
- Solicitation, or selling of items in or along the parade route is prohibited.
- The Butner Christmas Parade is a rain or shine event.
